Report on Activity at 9702 Grant Ave. – see New Business <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attempted armed robbery occurred at 9702 Grant Avenue creating concern for the community as the recent robbery, and past robberies, were perpetrated by non-GTS residents. The Board Members and staff of GTS request that the police intervene to reduce armed robbery on Grant.</li> </ul> </li> <li>3. Request for public information policy to be updated. When there is an incident in GTS, the police department issues communication and mention that a press release will get sent out without providing details. Lack of information from the police department contributes to a negative image of the community.
