C.	Police Report Crime in Georgetown South 2022 – 2023 <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Police Report: I am not including the actual 20-page police report because it is mostly about parking violations, just the same as every month. Other important activities are noted below. Report on Activity at 9702 Grant Ave via Lieutenant Hyde (in person) or CVO Rodriquez will be present to discuss CVO programs. Lieutenant Hyde reported that he has been promoted and will be leaving the Georgetown South community to be replaced by Sergeant Luis Armas. He also reported on the progress, or lack thereof, at 79702. The police department has not yet been able to meet with the family who lives there to try and work out a resolution. The PD is working with the Commonwealth's Attorneys' Office to try an innovative solution for that property. CVO Rodriquez reported that he is back in Georgetown South replacing CVO Brown. He also reported that there are two youth programs co-led by the MCPD that are up and running. They are Badges for Baseball Fall and Girls on the Run. CVO Rodriquez reported that the City PD won a VA Municipal League award for their Parent E3 series. One of the judges highlighted that their program was simultaneous in Spanish and English and while the officer did not say this, the simultaneous translation was entirely the brainchild of the Georgetown South office staff. Officer Rodriquez asked that everyone be patient with the youth of the current police department. Resident Conrad Runion complained about people not getting parking tickets that should and he blames overcrowding. He also thinks that vehicles should be towed even if they get and pay their parking tickets once they receive a certain number. Lieutenant Hyde told the resident to just call in his street name at night so that the community does not get blanketed with tickets.

Community Vitality Officer Program reports that CVO Rodriquez will be back with us full time effective immediately. CVO Rodriquez would like to host a Community Conversation around the "See Something, Say Something" topic. CM Carroll would like to use that as the impetus for a series called Community Conversations that will focus on various topics of interest and concern to the community. These will include Gun Violence, Domestic Violence, Bullying Prevention, Sexual Assault and Dating Violence, Opioid Awareness, Mental Health, and School Attendance. Community Manager Carroll mentioned that both she and CVO Rodriquez want to collaborate on a series called "Community Conversations" that will be early evening workshops talking about gun violence, vaping and other gateway drugs, opioid abuse among other topics. There is a need to communicate to our parents and residents the issues that are important around us.
